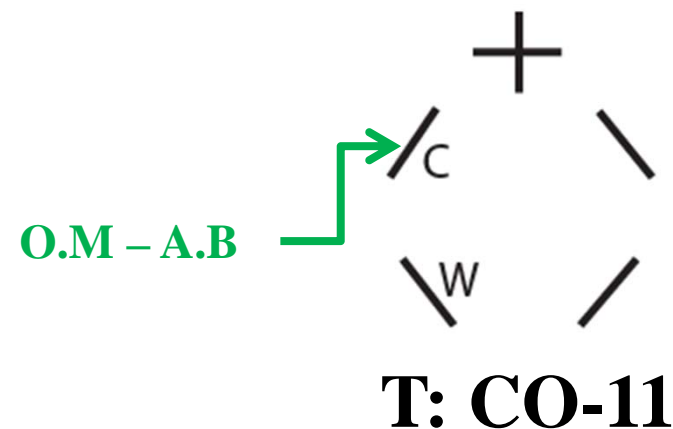

- **Difficulty to sleep at noon. Calm in a holiday party – he likes company.**
- **At the first nights – strong and dry coughs – the mother had to breath deeply. In the morning – big change, the coughs stopped and the rhinitis become minor.**
- **3 nights he slept – he even not asked for a bottle.**
- **3 nights ago sleep a bit less good, the rhinitis appear again.**
- **The wet cough was stable, and not developed as usual.**
- **Skeen – After the first day it looked better.**
- **More calm. Red face – less. Less Salivation – not sure.**

- **Today he received an Hepatitis A vaccine.**



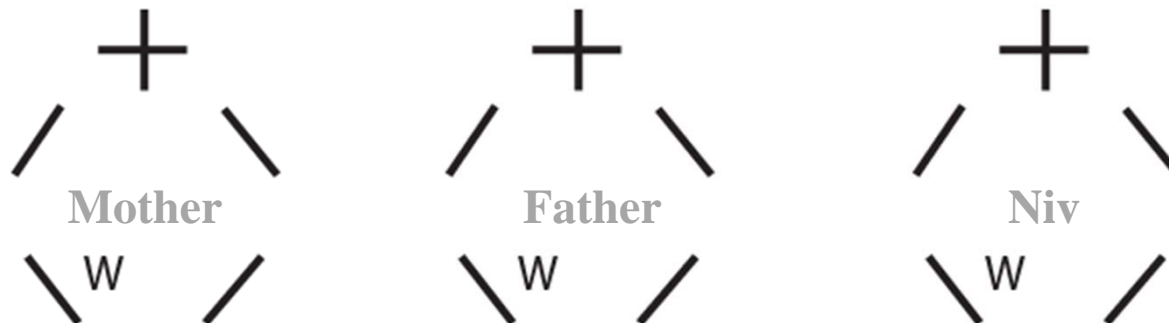
