Chief Complain:

- → Asthma Using Cingular already two and a half years. The treatment is very helpful and he now suffers from minor attacks. Now he use small amount of Ventolin (bronchodilator). In the past he was Hospitalized during sever attacks.
- This season is problematic. When he runs or very active, he coughs and get tired very quickly.
- Now he feel less good, Suffering from a runny nose and cough. No shortness of breath. His mood is getting low during asthma attacks, also now suffers from irritability, nervousness and a lot of cries.

Pregnancy: In all the pregnancies the mother suffers from diabetes. Big babies – he was burn 4.5 kilograms.

Appetite: OK. Like to eat sweets. Not so much picky.

Stools: Use to have difficulty. A year and a half ago he was hospitalized after asthma attack, he developed constipation. He was afraid from the pain and did not empty himself for 2 weeks.

Sleeping: Wakeup 2-3 times – fright.

Emotional:

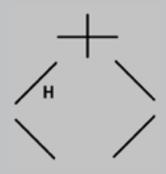
- Finds it difficult to say goodbye in the morning.

Asthma: OK. Still using Singuler.

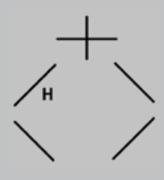
It was difficult to go back to the daycare after the holiday, he become sensitive.

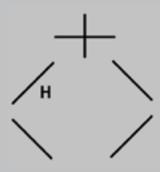
Coughing and tiredness after activity: Much less.

Sleeping: OK. Continues sleeping.

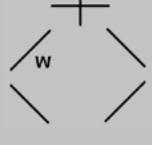
Rhinitis: Disappear. Yesterday he was for many hours in the swimming pull, the rhinitis come back, but disappear again.

Tonify *Treatment: SP-6*

It seems that the emotional level is improving and so the physical symptoms. The treatment task is to stabilize the KID and calm down the Emotional Wind in the LIV. SP-6 is suitable to this task.
